INFORMATION

ARRIVAL

Y Meirionnydd is situated in the centre of Dolgellau on the one way inner road. You can park on the road or immediately in front of the hotel's front door to unload luggage for up to 15 minutes. You can then park on the road or in the town car park.

PARKING

One of Dolgellau's main charms is that its narrow streets and alleyways are based on a medieval road plan. The flipside of this is that there are restrictions on parking during the daytime. We do not have a private car park but you may park to the front, to the side or indeed anywhere else in the immediate vicinity, subject to the usual public highway restrictions.

A one hour maximum stay applies from 9am until 6pm every day in most parts of the town, so including this one hour morning and evening you may usually park in the vicinity of the hotel from 5pm until 10am the next day. PLEASE CHECK THE SIGNAGE wherever you park as we cannot be liable for any parking tickets incurred during your stay.

If you need to leave your vehicle in town during the day you should leave it in the main car park situated on The Marion, about four hundred metres away. A small hourly fee applies but you should not leave it overnight.

BREAKFAST

Breakfast is from 08.00 until 09.00 Monday to Friday, 08.00 until 10.00 Saturday, Sunday & Bank Holiday Monday.

If you would like an earlier start in the morning we are happy to prepare a Continental style take away breakfast to include a juice, croissant, yoghurt etc, this can be ordered at check in.

BIKE STORAGE

We can store up to 6 bikes in our secure unit to the rear of the hotel subject to prior notice, no charge.

THE RESTAURANT AND BAR

Low Season (November to March) – opening times vary as this is our quiet season so check on our 'opening times' on the restaurant page or call us on 01341 422554.

High Season (April to October) – the restaurant will be open Tuesday to Saturday from 6.00pm and on some Sundays in August.

Unfortunately we are not able to cater for children under eight years old except for breakfast.
